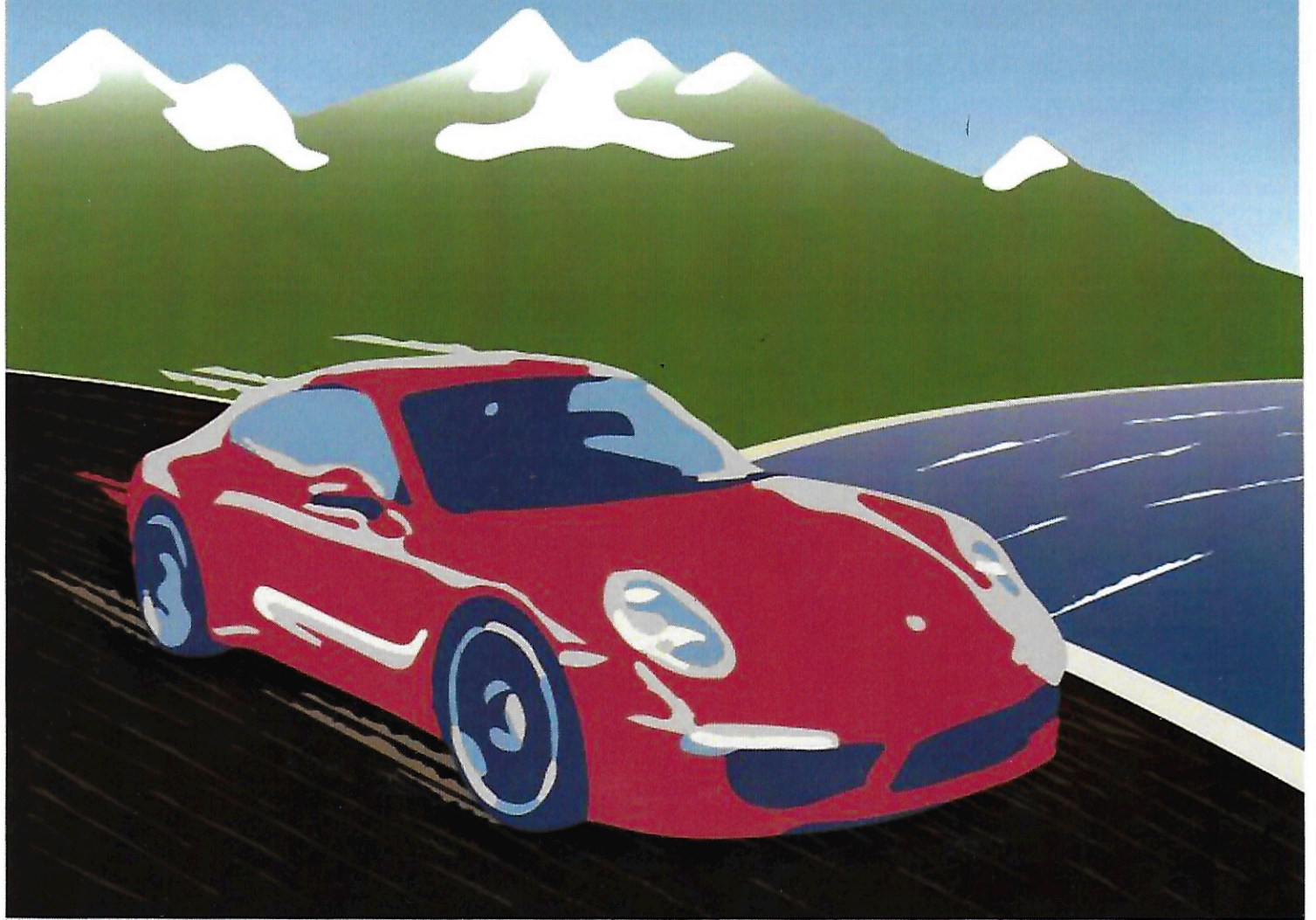

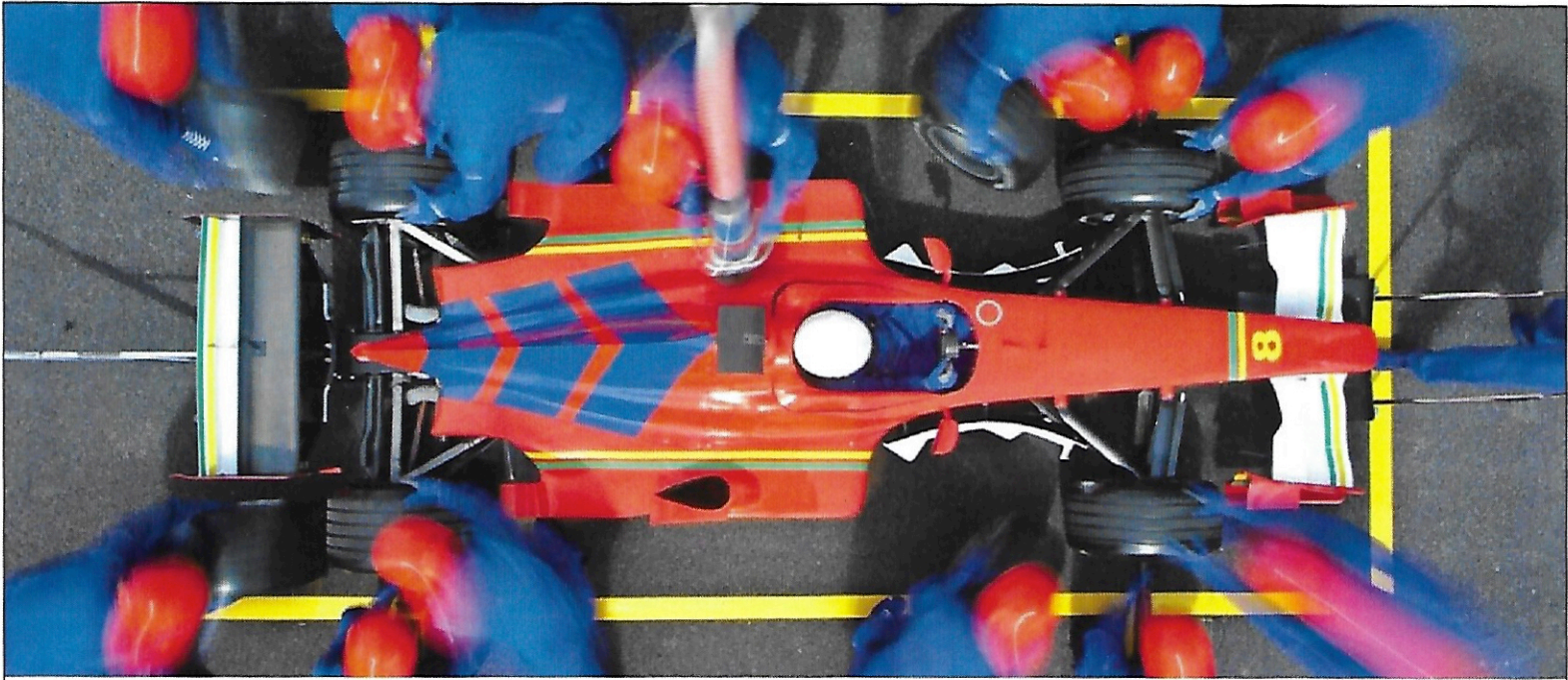

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## SAFE AND COURTEOUS DRIVING ON THE NORTHWEST PASSAGE

This event is sanctioned by and insured by the Porsche Club of America (PCA). In order to apply for, keep in force, and maintain our ability to obtain liability insurance for the Northwest Passage it is essential that we do our best to abide by PCA tour driving standards. Without this insurance there is no Northwest Passage, period.

**UNSAFE OR DANGEROUS DRIVING WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.** The Northwest Passage is not a race, rally or any form of competition and aggressive driving and/or extreme speeding will not be tolerated. Sanctions may be imposed on drivers who are found at fault at the sole discretion of the Northwest Passage Organizing Committee. These sanctions can include a verbal warning, expulsion from the current tour, and/or expulsion from the future Northwest Passage events.

If you witness any unsafe or dangerous driving by a tour participant, please report it to a Northwest Passage Committee member wearing a red lanyard.

If a driver is involved in an accident that causes vehicle and/or property damage, the Northwest Passage Organizing Committee will evaluate the circumstances and decide if sanctions will be imposed on the driver. These sanctions can include a verbal warning, expulsion from the current tour, and/or expulsion from the future Northwest Passage events.

For a safe and enjoyable tour for all, please show courtesy to your fellow participants and the public by observing the following guidelines:

- Obey all traffic laws.
- We pass through many small towns on our route, please make sure you observe and obey their speed limits, typically 25 – 35 MPH.
- Slower drivers pull over or slow down on a straightaway to let faster cars pass you.
- Faster drivers be patient and do not tailgate. Wait for a safe opportunity to pass.
- Don't pass when there is a solid double yellow line in your lane or there will be one before you are able to complete your pass.
- Don't throw gravel and road debris on participants or public cars that you just passed. Allow plenty of room before pulling back into your lane.

# Route Instructions

**SEQUENCE:** As in any sports car rally, take instructions in strict numerical sequence. They are in chronological order from start to finish in spite of zeroing your odometer at a number of places within the route.

**MILEAGE:** Mileage is cumulative since the most recent instruction. An effort is made to make the mileage as accurate as possible, but planning logistics frequently cause us to measure mileage in more than one vehicle. Consequently, take all mileage indications as somewhat approximate. **Your Mileage Will Vary (but only slightly)!**

**PARENTHETICALS:** Portions of the route instructions that are in parentheses will generally be references to words on signs or additional suggestions to help you understand the instruction.

**OPTIONAL STOPS:** We have mentioned several of the best stops along the route, but feel free to stop whenever something appeals to you or your companion. Just make sure to get to the next meal on time!

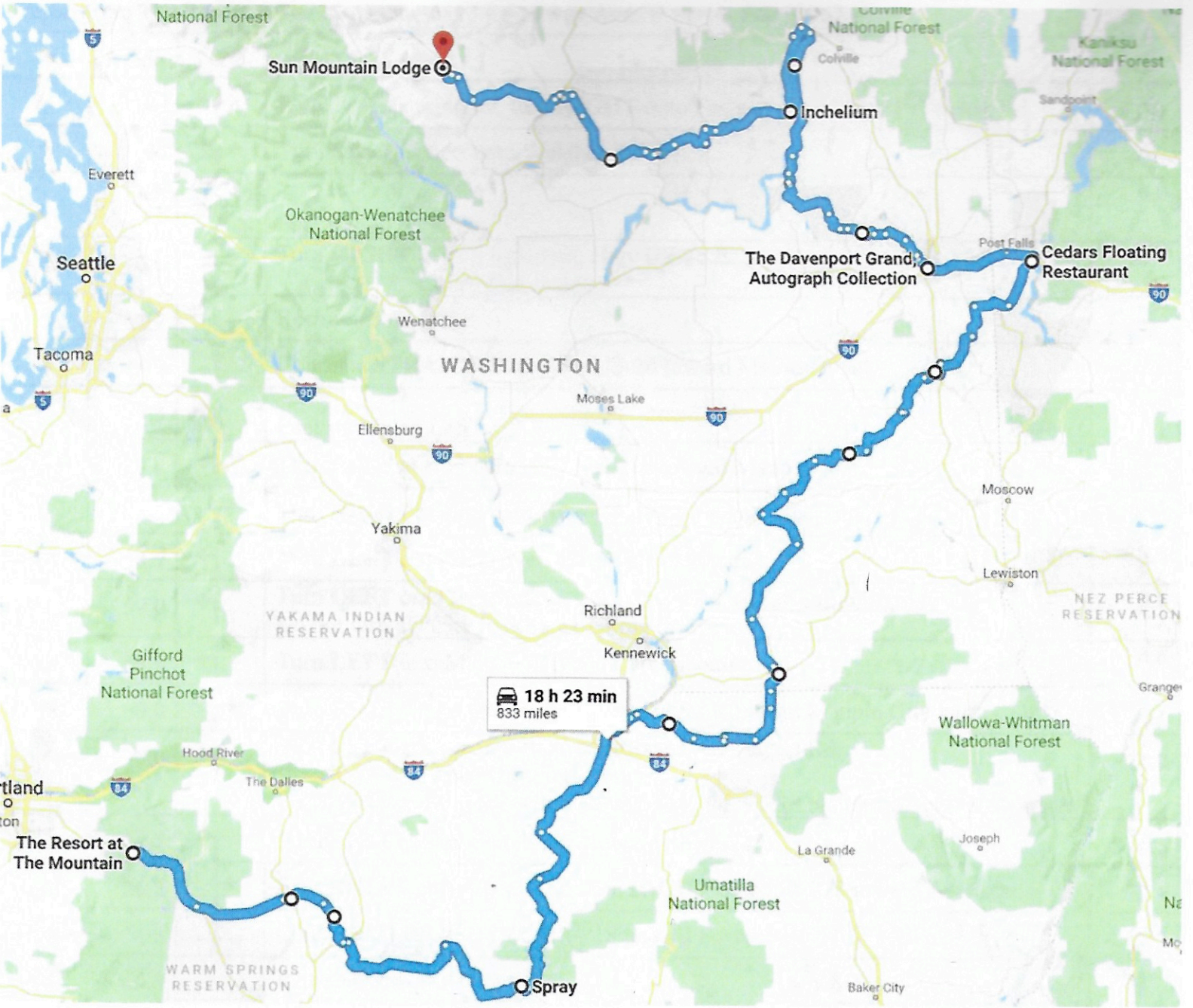
**CATTLE ON THE ROAD:** Ranchers use the road to move their cattle herds from one field to another. If you come upon a herd of cattle in the road coming toward you:

- Stop your car toward the middle of the road, leaving room for the cattle to get by on both sides of your car.
- Stay in your car. If you get out of the car, the cattle think you are trying to herd them in a different direction.
- Pull up to the bumper of the car ahead of you so that the cattle cannot go between the cars.

If the herd of cattle is going in the same direction as you, be patient and follow the herd until the road is clear.



# 2019 Northwest Passage – Map of Entire Route

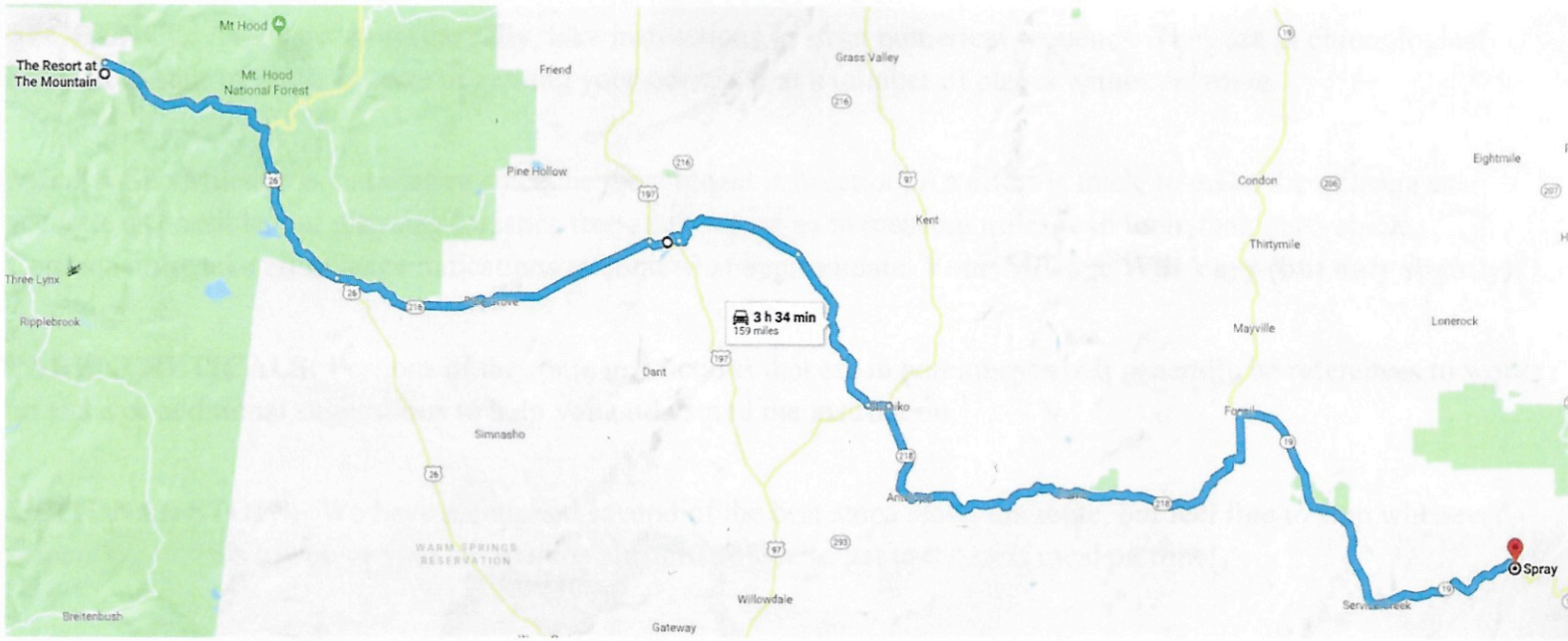
