2025 Accomplishments

○ **New formats of drives and tours**

- Created new drive offerings: the long-day drive (thank you Fred & Mark), themed drives like GT Car Drive, Drive with Pride, and Summer Evening
- Introduction of Scenic Oregon – an all inclusive, luxury-forward, multiday tour

○ **New formats of Social Gatherings**

- Launched Road & Fork series of smaller dinner gatherings, F1 Viewing parties, and happy hours
