



SCENIC APP Quick Users Guide

February 2024

Overview

SCENIC is a digital navigation App that runs on iPhones. It allows point-to-point navigation on a defined route, supports Apple Car Play, has offline maps so you have accurate navigation without cell phone reception, and has Voice Guidance. We started using this app about four years ago after an evaluation with several other, similar apps. We maintain a club account with a library of club drives. You are free to use the club account (just don't delete or edit any of the routes), or you can use your own Scenic account and upload routes.

If you use another navigation app e.g., one that runs on Android, we publish for most of our drives and tours a link to the Scenic App Space that allows you to download the route to your phone and import it into the app of your choice.


As with all navigation apps, there are limitations when the circle of uncertainty is wider than neighboring navigation points (caused by insufficient number of satellites in reception) or by differences of the digital maps and the actual location of navigation points.

Navigation apps don't replace written driving directions and common sense.

To use the app, follow these steps:



Install the App




Install: Go to the App Store on your iPhone and search for Scenic. Then download and open the app.

Log-In




Tap LOG IN






Successful Login




Tap "OK"

Go to the Account Settings




Tap the Account Logo (top right, the ORPCA logo)

Select Premium Offline Maps




Tap "OFFLINE MAPS"

Update Map Version




Tap “Update Map Version” – this will update your downloaded maps

Download Maps




If you see this screen, you have no downloaded maps. Download maps of Oregon and Washington and other states as needed

Download Maps – Step 1



Tap "North and Central America"

Select Oregon and Washington Maps for download




Scroll down until you see "United States – Oregon"

Tap "USA – Oregon" and wait for download to complete.


Tap "USA – Washington" and wait for download to complete.

Successful Download



After successful download you will see the erase icon to the right of each downloaded map

Tap "< PROFILE". (Top left)


Tap "OFFLINE MAPS"

If you see the list of downloaded maps you are all set up


Tap "< PROFILE"

Return to Main Menu




Tap the menu icon (Top left)

Find the Folder for your Routes




After Taping “Routes” you will see a horizontal list of folders on top of the screen.

Tap the Folder “ORPCA 2024”

A vertical list of all routes in that folder will appear.

Scroll, Find and Tap the route you want to drive



Select Routes



The Route Overview Screen will appear showing route distance, driving time and more.


There’s a list of orange buttons on the bottom that allow you to start the navigation, share the route or export the GPX data of the route.

Route Overview



If you **Tap** the Mountain Icon on the right side of the map you will see the altitude profile of the route


Navigate the Route



Tap “Navigate” to initiate the route navigation. You can choose in the “Guidance to route” box to get directions to the start of the route. The screen shows the start and end point as well as the way points. The big orange button on the bottom starts the actual navigation.

Tap “START NAVIGATION”

Navigation Screen



After you tapped “START NAVIGATION” the navigation screen appears. It shows the current location, the route ahead, the mileage to the next turn, the turn direction, and the name of the road for the turn. It also shows remaining distance, time to destination and arrival time. The screen also shows the current speed and the speed limit.

Navigation Screen




If you tap the symbol with the 9 little squares in the lower right, this screen appears.

This screen allows quick access to route overview, map north up, 3D Maps, unlock orientation as well as changing the volume of the voice guidance.


The gear wheel icon leads to an extended settings menu for navigation and map options

Stop Navigation



To stop the navigation, tap the icon on the lower left side of the navigation screen. This screen will appear. It allows to pause the ride and to stop the ride.


Ending Navigation



To end the Drive / Navigation, Tap “Finish Ride”


The Navigation automatically ends when you reach the end point. If you would like to end or pause the navigation on the route, tap the time to destination field.

Extended Settings Menu



To Reach the Extended Menu Settings, Tap the menu icon and then Tap SETTINGS


Extended Settings Menu



The Settings Menu allows full customization of most app functions.


The two most important ones are MAP SETTINGS and NAVIGATION & TRACKING

Map Settings




In this menu you can select what is shown on the navigation screen.

Navigation & Tracking




This menu allows you to configure the navigation screen and navigation behavior.

Detour Behavior



This screen is important. It allows you to configure the navigation behavior when a detour from the planned route is recognized and the way the app guides you back to the original route.

Map Options



If you Tap the Map Icon (top left below the menu icon) on the Home Screen / Navigation Screen, you can select different map styles.
